**We want you to know that CHOP policy doesn't allow staff to accept personal gifts.** We have this policy so no patient or family ever has to worry about giving any member of our staff a personal gift.

**Please be assured that a simple "thank you" is always welcomed and appreciated.**

If you still want to give a staff member a token of appreciation, a note of thanks or a drawing from your child would be warmly received.
