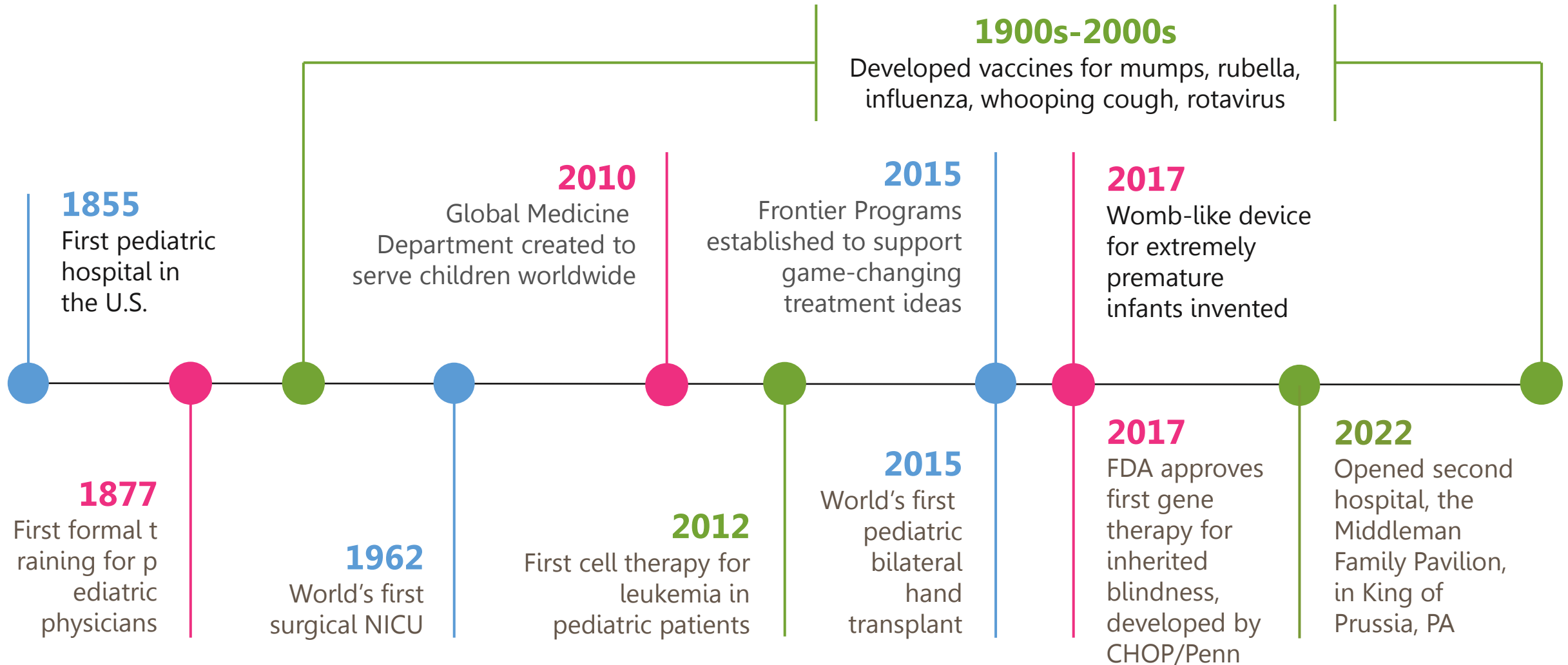

Care Network Map

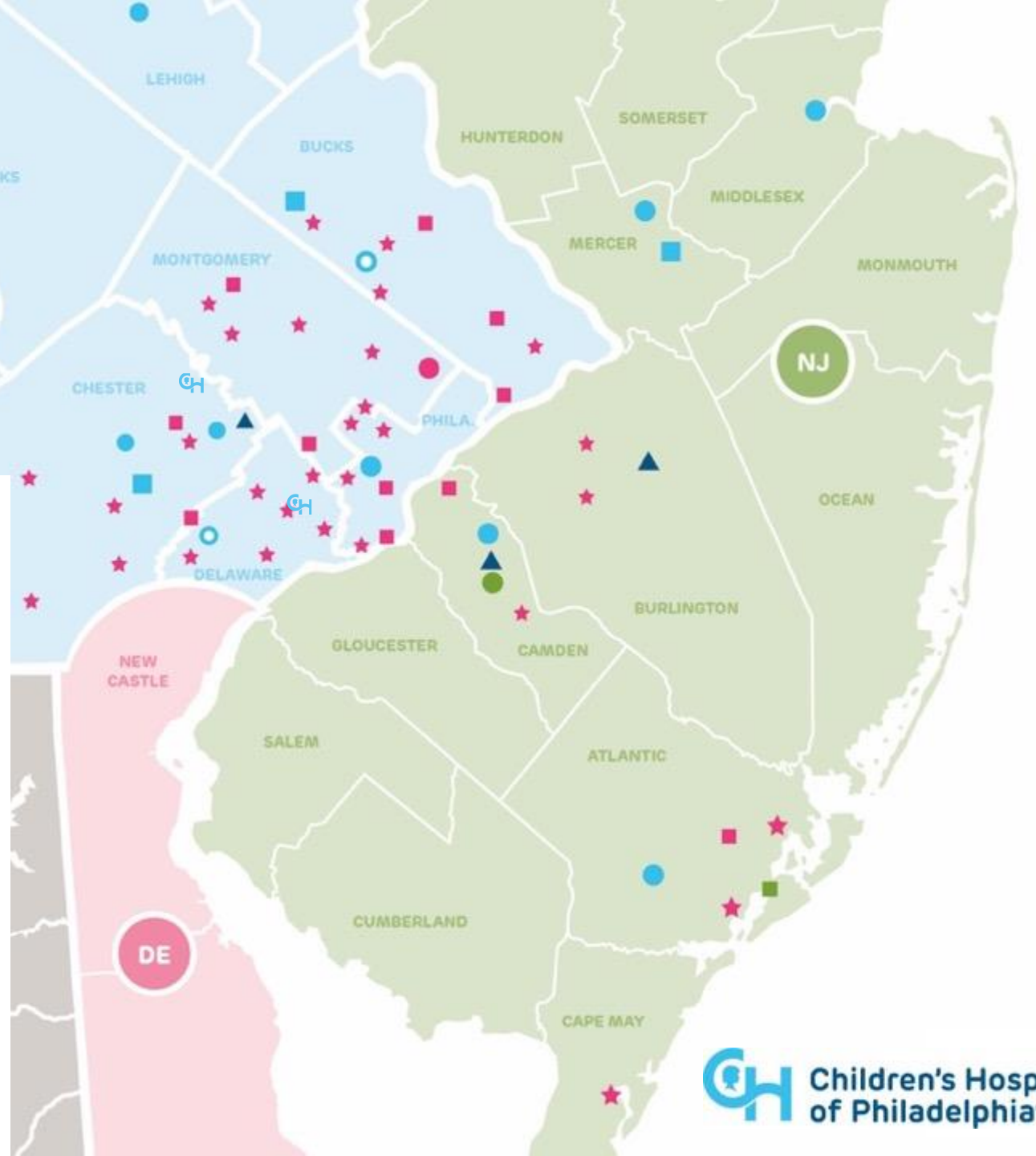

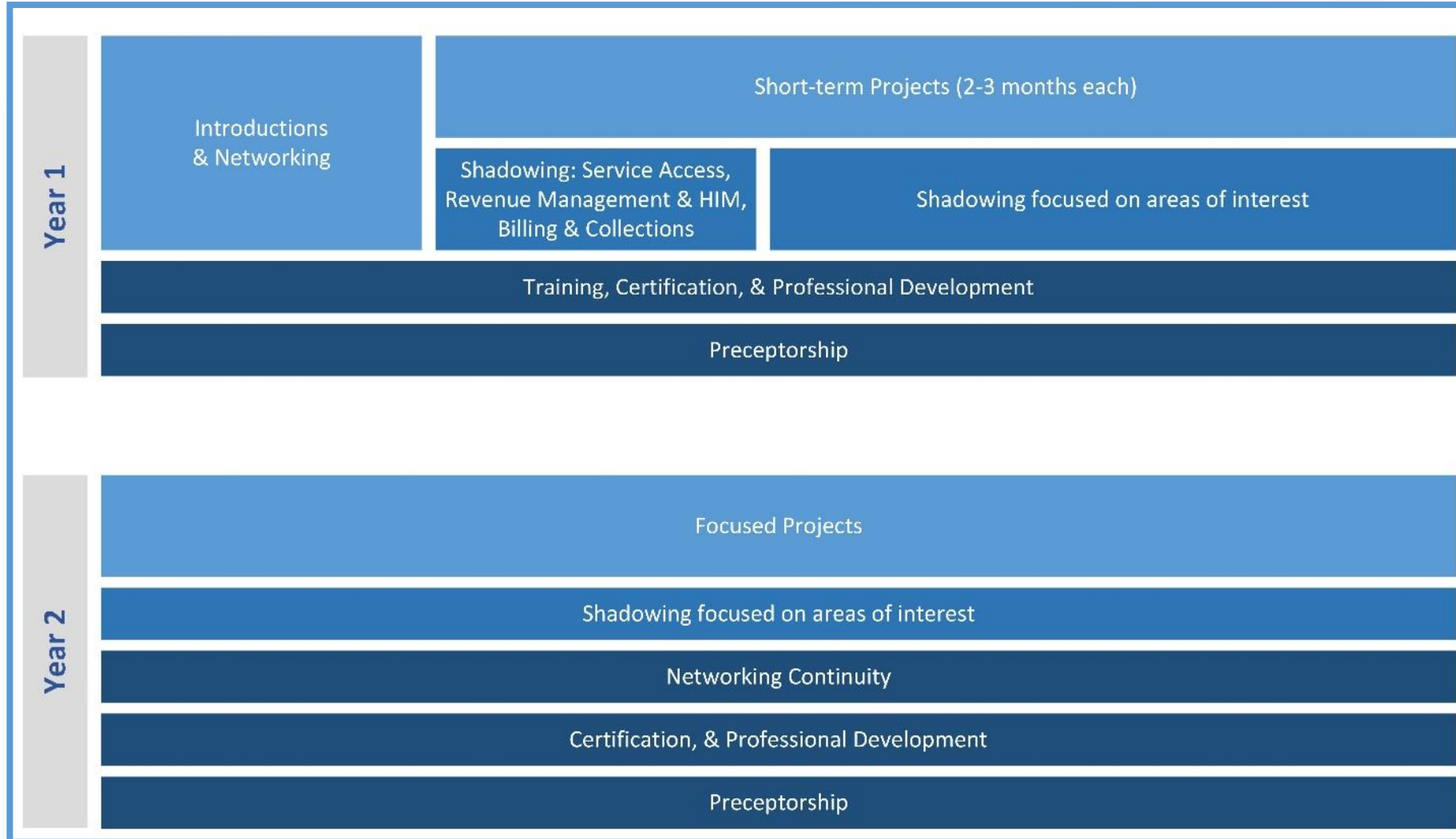

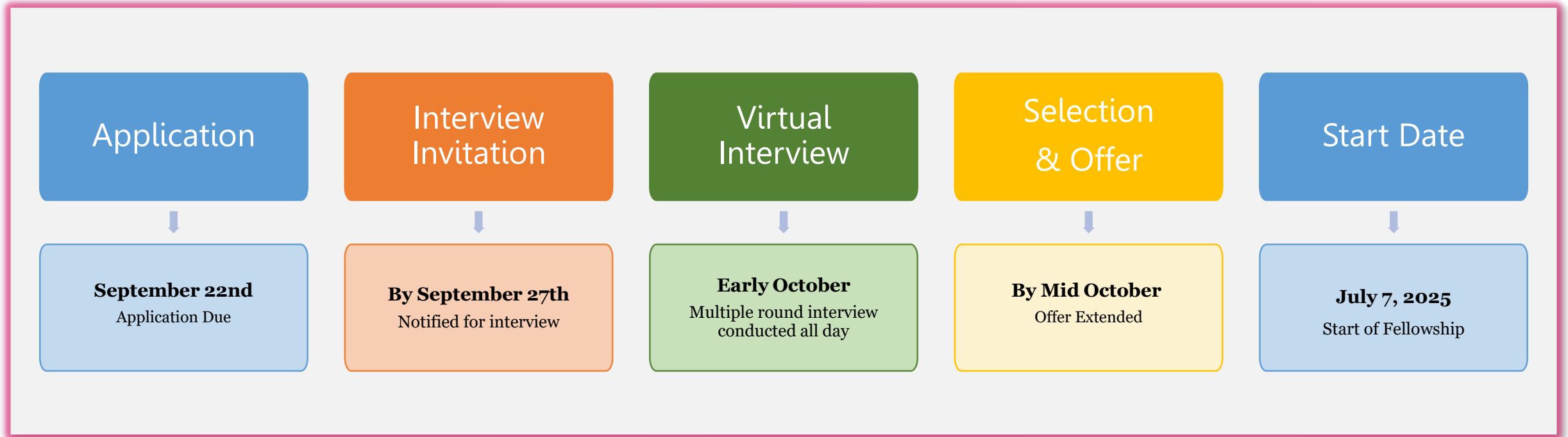
