Thank you for your interest in the Reach Out and Read (ROR) program at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) Primary Care Centers. Reach Out and Read, a national nonprofit organization started in Boston in 1989, works to strengthen families with young children through guidance from medical clinicians about nurturing relationships through shared reading. We envision a world where every child has the relationships essential to learn and thrive. There are 6,200 primary care health centers in the nation that have ROR. **In deep partnership with a network of clinicians, ROR leverages the near-universal reach of the pediatric well-child visit, using brand-new children's books and shared reading to support parents and caregivers in fostering healthy relationships with their infants and young children, from newborn through 5 years old. Reach Out and Read works directly with pediatric primary care medical providers to share the lifelong benefits that result from parents reading aloud with their children every day.**

Reach Out and Read at CHOP started in 1996 and is implemented at 22 CHOP Primary Care Centers located in Northwest, West and South Philadelphia, the Pennsylvania suburbs (Broomall, Chalfont, Coatesville, Collegeville, Kennett Square, Media, Norristown, Pottstown, Souderton, Springfield, West Chester and West Grove), and the New Jersey suburbs (Burlington Township, Gibbsboro and Moorestown). Reach Out and Read is also incorporated at seven CHOP Neonatal Follow-up Programs and one Cardiac Developmental Follow-up Program. **This year, the CHOP ROR primary care doctors and nurse practitioners will need to provide 162,000+ brand-new books to 100,000 young patients, ages newborn through 5 years.**

DONATING BOOKS TO REACH OUT AND READ

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The Reach Out and Read program is implemented at 22 CHOP Primary Care Centers located in Northwest, West and South Philadelphia, the Pennsylvania suburbs (Broomall, Chalfont, Coatesville, Collegeville, Kennett Square, Media, Norristown, Pottstown, Souderton, Springfield, West Chester and West Grove), and the New Jersey suburbs (Burlington Township, Gibbsboro and Moorestown). Reach Out and Read is also at seven CHOP Neonatal Follow-up Programs and one Cardiac Developmental Follow-up Program.

The staff and families at these outpatient primary care centers truly appreciate donations of funds and or appropriate, wonderful children's books. Below are guidelines that were developed out of respect for families and in keeping with the philosophy of Reach Out and Read – every child deserves good quality books.

NEW BOOKS

- In order for the CHOP primary care pediatricians and nurse practitioners to provide new books in the exam rooms during well visits and promote best practices for parents and children, the Reach Out and Read program needs **funds** to purchase at least 162,000 brand-new, developmentally, culturally and linguistically appropriate books annually for 100,000 patients, ages newborn through 5 years old.
- We are always in great need of brand-new books for infants and toddlers (newborn, 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 24 and 30 months old). **The Reach Out and Read program coordinator at CHOP purchases the new books, at a significant discount, that our Reach Out and Read sites need for their patient families.
