Audiology Student Experiences

Description of the Placement:

The graduate student experiences may include comprehensive diagnostic and rehabilitative hearing services for children from birth to 21 years of age. Primary setting is dependent on semester and preceptor availability.

As a practicum student, you will be assigned to a preceptor/co-preceptors and complete your internship at their primary location or locations. Travel may be expected based on your preceptor(s) location. Daily schedules are determined with your preceptor prior to the start date.

Requirements:

- Third year Doctor of Audiology student, academically strong student with experience in and interest in pediatric placements
- Affiliation Agreement with the University that may be obtained after student is accepted

Application deadlines

Fall semester (starting late August to early September): *May 15th* Spring semester (starting early to mid-January): *September 15th* Summer session (starting mid to late May or later): *February 15th*

Selection Process:

Students may be competing with each other (from several universities) for a select number of internships each semester. Internships are offered when CHOP Audiology preceptors are available.

Student observers must complete a list of background checks and clearances similar to any student completing an internship.

*The clearance process is initiated by CHOP Human Resources. Students are informed of requirements via email. The process takes 4-6 weeks. Students are not permitted to observe until approved by CHOP Human Resources. It is up to the student to ensure that this process is completed including any expenses required.
