Other names: albuterol and ipratropium

brand names are Combivent®, DuoNeb®

Type of medicine: Bronchodilator

Why you need it: Inhalation of this medication is used to treat

bronchospasm

How it is given: Inhaled

Side effects: Tiredness, nausea, fever

Tips for Taking

- 1. Do not use albuterol and ipratropium inhaler if you are allergic to soybeans, peanuts, or other food products that contain soya lecithin.
- 2. When using the inhaler for the first time, prime it by spraying 2 test sprays into the air away from your face. Also prime the inhaler if you have not used it for 3 days or longer.
- 3. Shake the canister vigorously for at least 10 seconds before each spray.
- 4. If you need more than one inhalation of medication at a time, wait at least 2 minutes before taking the second inhalation
- Clean your inhaler once per week by holding it under warm running water for 30 seconds or more. Allow parts to dry and put inhaler back together.
- 6. Store device in a cool dry place.
